Our Addiction Awareness Program (AAP) is specifically designed for first time drug and alcohol related offenders who meet the criteria for Early Intervention Services and complete a Level of Care (LOC) Assessment.

Participants attend two individual sessions and four, weekly consecutive group sessions, each two hours in length.

A basic addiction education curriculum including the disease concept, cycles of addiction, the physical effects of alcohol, and relapse prevention is provided.
